April 2017

The Consumer Prices Index in Phnom Penh was increased by 0.4% from April to March 2017. Over the last twelve months prices have increased 3.2%. In March 2017the rate of inflation was 4.3%. The Consumer Price Index for April 2017 has been calculated at 169.4.

April to March 2017

From March to March 2017 Price for meat increased by 0.7% and contribution by 0.1% units. Main increase for this group was due to increase price for pork increased by 1.1% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for fish and seafood increased by 1.1% and contribution by 0.1% units. Main increase for this group was due to increase price for fresh fish increased by 1.0% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for rice increased by 0.1%. Price for vegetables increased by 1.1% and contribution by 0.1% units. Main increase this group was due to increase price for leaf and stalk vegetables increased by 1.4%; price for fruit vegetables increased by 1.0% and price for root vegetables increased by 1.7%. Price for food products increased by 0.3%. Price for clothing increased by 0.5%. Price for furnishings, household equipment and routine household maintenance increased by 1.0%. Price for restaurants increased by 0.7% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for miscellaneous goods and services increased by 0.5%. While, Price for fruits decreased by 0.5%. Price for health decreased by 0.2%. Price for communication decreased by 0.4%. Price for recreation and culture decreased by 0.8%.

April 2017 to April 2016

Of the total consumer price increased by 3.2% from April 2016 to April 2017, 2.1% units were due to increase by 3.8% for food and non-alcoholic beverages. Price for rice increased by 2.3% and contribution by 0.3% units. Price for meat increased by 3.4% and contribution by 0.4% units. Main increase for this group was due to increase price for pork increased by 3.8% and contribution by 0.4% units. Price for beef increased by 3.2% and price for chicken increased by 3.5% and contribution by 0.1% units each. Price for fish and seafood increased by 7.9% and contribution by 0.9% units. Main increase for this group was due to increase price for fresh fish increased by 8.4% and contribution by 0.7% units. Price for processed fish increased by 6.4% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for vegetables increased by 5.4% and contribution by 0.3% units. Main increase this group was due to increase price for leaf and stalk vegetables increased by 6.9% and contribution by 0.2% units. Price for fruit vegetables increased by 4.6% and Price for root vegetables increased by 10.6% and contribution by 0.1% units each. Price for sugar, jam, honey, chocolate increased by 6.9% and price for food product increased by 5.3% and contribution by 0.1% units each. Main increased for food group was due to increase of rice; meat; fish and seafood; fruits and vegetables and food products. Price for alcoholic beverage and tobacco increased by 3.0%. Main increase this group was due to increase price for tobacco increased by 4.8%. Price for clothing and footwear increased by 2.7% and contribution by 0.1% units. Main increase this group was due to increase price for clothing increased by 3.0% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels increased by 0.4% and contribution by 0.1% units. Main increase for this group was due to increase price for maintenance and repair of the dwelling increased by 1.8% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for furnishings, household equipment and routine household maintenance increased by 2.6% and contribution by 0.1% units. Price for health increased by 1.2% and contribution by 0.1% units. Main increase for this group was due to increase price medical products, appliances and equipment increased by 1.4%. Price for transport increased by 5.9% and contribution by 0.5% units. Main increase for this group was due to increase price for gasoline increased by 15.5% and contribution by 0.4% units. Price for recreation and culture increased by 1.6%. Price for restaurants increased by 4.1% and contribution by 0.4% units. Price for miscellaneous goods and services increased by 0.4%. While, price for fruits decreased by 0.8% and contribution by -0.1% units. Main decrease this group was due to decrease price for fresh fruits decreased by 0.9% and contribution by -0.1% units. Price for communication decreased by 0.7%.

The increased for all index group 3.2% rate of inflation in April 2017 was due to the sub-groups such as: food and non-alcoholic beverages; alcoholic beverages and tobacco; clothing and footwear; housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels; furnishings, household equipment and routine household maintenance; health; Transport; recreation and culture; restaurants and miscellaneous goods and services.
